## **II . Length of Study**

- (I) Bachelor’s program: 4-6 years.  
Master’s program: 1-4 years.  
Doctoral program: 2-7 years.
- (II) According to Article 9, paragraph 2 of “Standards for Recognition of Equivalent Educational Levels for University Admission”,: A student who graduated in a foreign country, Hong Kong, or Macao from a senior secondary school whose graduating year is academically equivalent to the second grade of a senior secondary school in Taiwan of a comparable academic level and nature is considered to have adequate academic ability and may take the entrance examination for new students for university bachelor’s degree programs. However, these students will have to take 12 more credits in addition to the total required credits for graduation.

## **III . Eligibility of Applicants**

- 1 、 An individual of foreign nationality who has never held nationality status from the Republic of China (R.O.C.) and who does not hold status as an overseas Chinese student at the time of their application.
- 2 、 An individual of foreign nationality who meets the requirements below and will have resided overseas (excluding Hong Kong, Macau and mainland China) continuously for no less than 6 years prior to August 1 in the year and whose stays in Taiwan per calendar year do not exceed a total of 120 days.
  - (1) An individual who also holds nationality status from the R.O.C., but has no history of household registration in Taiwan.
  - (2) An individual who previously held nationality status from the R.O.C., but who has already renounced that nationality status at the time of application, and the nationality will have been annulled by the Ministry of the Interior for no less than eight years as of August 1 in the year.
  - (3) An individual mentioned in the above 2 subparagraphs must not have studied in Taiwan under the status of an overseas Chinese student nor received placement through the University Entrance Committee for Overseas Chinese Students in the enrollment year.
- 3 、 An individual of foreign nationality who concurrently holds permanent residence status in Hong Kong or Macao, has no record of household registration in Taiwan, and will have resided in Hong Kong, Macao or another foreign country (excluding mainland China) for no less than 6 years prior to August 1 in the year and whose stays in Taiwan per calendar year do not exceed a total of 120 days.
- 4 、 An individual who is a former citizen of mainland China and holds foreign nationality,

has no record of household registration in Taiwan, and will have resided overseas (excluding Hong Kong, Macau and mainland China) continuously for no less than 6 years prior to August 1 in the year, and whose stays in Taiwan per calendar year do not exceed a total of 120 days.

- 5、If an applicant meets one of the conditions below and can provide supporting documents, then his/her time spent in Taiwan for the reasons specified below will not be calculated as part of the 120 day limit:
- (1) The applicant attended overseas youth training courses organized by the Overseas Compatriot Affairs Council or technical training classes accredited by MOE.
  - (2) The applicant attended classes at a Mandarin Chinese language center at a university/college approved by the Ministry of Education(MOE) for recruiting international students, and whose period of study was less than 2 years.
  - (3) The applicant was an exchange student who was on exchange for less than 2 years.
  - (4) The applicant whose internship position in Taiwan was approved by an authorized central government agency, and lasted for less than 2 years.
- 6、Applicants who have graduated from a high school, college or university recognized by Taiwan's Ministry of Education may apply for admission (please refer to the MOE's Database for the Reference List of Foreign Universities). International students with a high school diploma are eligible to apply for undergraduate programs; bachelor's degree holders for Master's programs; Master's degree holders for Doctoral program.

Applicants should submit their application from February 1 to April 30, 2021 with the required documents (see below).

#### **V. Application Documents & Notes**

##### **( I ) Application Documents Required**

International students must submit the following documents (translated into English or Chinese) to the Admission Division, Office of Academic Affairs, National Taiwan University of Sport.

- 1、Documents required by all applicants

- (1) Two copies of the enrollment application form (Attachment 1).
- (2) One copy of the applicant's highest-level diploma and one copy of the academic transcript authenticated by R.O.C. Embassies and Missions Abroad. (Please attach its Chinese or English version certified by the overseas representative office of Taiwan if the original diploma or transcript is not in English or Chinese).

Note: Academic credentials from Hong Kong or Macao shall be handled in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations Governing the Examination and Recognition of Educational Qualifications from Hong Kong and Macao. Academic credentials from the Mainland Area shall be handled in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations Regarding the Assessment and Recognition of Academic Credentials from Mainland Area.

- (3) One copy of the biographical page of passport or verification of nationality.
- (4) Certification of finances: A financial statement with a minimum balance of US\$3,300(or NTD 100,000) or a copy of a scholarship award notification. (Please select one of the following methods:)
  - ① A financial statement that demonstrates financial sustainability for study in Taiwan (issued by a financial institution within the past three months).
  - ② If the depositor of the certificate is not the applicant, a financial guarantee is also required (see Attachment 2).
  - ③ Proof of full scholarship provided by a government agency, university, college, or private organization.
- (5) Certificate of language proficiency : Applicants applying for Southeast Asian Doctoral Program of Sport Management must submit the proof of English proficiency. Other applicants must submit the certificate of Chinese language proficiency.

Note: Indonesian students applying for a bachelor's degree program (master's and doctoral programs not included) must submit a certificate of language proficiency, as specified below (choose one):

- ① Sertifikat TOCFL dengan tingkatan diatas A2
- ② Nilai TOEFL: nilai iBT diatas 26 / ITP diatas 385
- ③ Nilai TOEIC diatas 375
- ④ Nilai IELTS diatas 3.0

- ② Other evidence of the applicant's public performances, such as programs, award certificates, etc. The applicant's name should be listed on all of the supporting documents.

(2) Doctoral Program in Department of Sport Performance

- ① Resume (A4, no specified style)
- ② Study Plan and Research Proposal
- ③ Personal achievement or work portfolio
- ④ Research publications

### (3) Southeast Asian Doctoral Program of Sport Management

- ① Resume (A4, no specified style)
- ② Photocopies of certificates of merit, licenses, or professional certifications
- ③ Personal achievement or work portfolio
- ④ Research publications

### ( II ) **Important Notes**

- 1 、 Courses are mostly conducted in Chinese, except for Southeast Asian Doctoral Program of Sport Management. Applicants are required to have basic Chinese reading, writing, speaking, and listening proficiency.
- 2 、 Southeast Asian Doctoral Program of Sport Management courses are conducted in English.
- 3 、 All the submitted documents will not be returned, please kept additional backup copies for yourself.
- 4 、 International students who have been forced to drop out by any institution in Taiwan due to their behavior problems, failed academic performances or criminal records are not allowed to apply for admission. Should any of the above violation cases be verified, the applicant's student status will be revoked immediately.
- 5 、 **International students applying for schools in Taiwan shall be limited to one application only.** Upon completion of the course of study, at a school in Taiwan, to which an international student has applied, the student's application to another school's academic level shall be handled in a manner identical to the application procedures for local students. For application of master's program or higher levels of graduate studies, follow the application procedures of each individual school.
- 6 、 Admission shall be denied and/or the student shall be dismissed from National Taiwan University of Sport after admission if there are any violations of the general academic honor code and/or in the authenticity of the applicant's documents. Those who have graduated shall have their diploma revoked.
- 7 、 Applicants, in accordance with the provisions of the Personal Data Protection Law, allow NTUS to hold and keep their personal information for the purpose of application evaluation and enrollment matter NTUS will have the obligation and responsibility to keep applicants' personal informational for the use of enrollment related matter only. After submitting the application forms all applicants are considered granting the university the right to use their personal information for all enrollment related matter.
- 8 、 Applicants should provide accurate contact information on the application form. Applicants fail to respond to any notification any notification from NTUS before deadline will be regarded as giving up their rights.



- 9、For all other related information, please refer to the Ministry of Education's "Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan", and the regulation of National Taiwan University of Sport (NTUS), or other related guidelines.

## **VI. Application Evaluation**

- ( I ) Applications will first be evaluated by the Admission Division of NTUS. After the initial review, the application materials will be sent to the prospective departments for further review.

- ( II ) Webcam or Face-to-face Interviews

Applicants for Doctoral Programs shall attend the interview if the documents meet the standard. It will be a webcam or face-to-face interview. Detail information will be given to the applicant by E-mail or phone from the departments. Please make sure that you can be reached by the contact information provided.

## **VII. Admission method**

- ( I ) Admission methods for bachelor's and master's programs: 100% on written documents, and admission is based on the results of the department review.

- ( II ) Admission method of Doctoral program:

- 1、Doctoral Program in Department of Sport Performance:

30% on the resume, personal achievement or work portfolio, and research publication; 30% on study plan and research proposal; 40% on the interview. The priority of admission is given based on the total score.

- 2、Southeast Asian Doctoral Program of Sport Management:

50% on the documents, 50% on the interview, and the priority of admission is given based on the total score.

- 3、If there is a decimal point in a score, it will be rounded up to the second decimal place.

- 4、For the last place, the last place, if there are multiple candidates with the same total score, the one with the higher score on the interview will be given priority.

- 5、There can be a waiting list. For those who are on the waiting list, if a vacancy is not filled by a qualified applicant after the end of registration period, the vacancy may be filled by candidates on the waiting list may be filled by candidates on the waiting list before the first date of the next semester.

## **VIII. Result Announcement**

- (I) The announcement of admissions result will be posted on

- ( II ) Admitted students shall come to the Registration Division for registration before the deadline as outlined in the notification letter. Students who fail to register by the closing date forfeit their admission to the university.
- ( III ) Any matters not stipulated in the admission guide shall be handled in accordance with the university's regulations for governing the admission of international students.

## **IX. Score Review**

- ( I ) Deadline for score review: 10 days after the results have been E-mailed. Application for score review after the deadline will not be processed.
- ( II ) Process for review
  1. To apply by E-mail, please scan the documents (Attachment 4) and E-mail to: [royeyain@gm.ntupes.edu.tw](mailto:royeyain@gm.ntupes.edu.tw)
  2. Requests for regrading file retrieval, photocopy of scoring table, or explanation of the grading standard, will be denied.
  3. Should the score of a disqualified candidate be found to have satisfied the threshold for qualification upon review, the candidate may be reallocated to become a qualified candidate.
  4. Should the score of a qualified candidate be found to have failed to meet the threshold for qualification upon review, the qualification shall be revoked and the candidate shall not raise any objections.

## **X. Objections and Complaints**

Applicants who have any doubts regarding the admission or doubts on possible violation of gender equality, may submit a written complaint (which includes the reason for complaint, name of examinee, and contacting phone number) to the admissions committee within a week after the official release of the results (based on the postmark date). The admissions committee will make an official reply within a month upon receiving the complaint, and an investigation panel may be assembled when necessary.

## **XI. Enrollment**

- ( I ) Admitted students must submit the following documents to complete their enrollment:
  1. One copy of the highest-level diploma and one copy of the full academic transcript (both translated into English or Chinese) authenticated by an ROC embassy or mission abroad.

2. One photocopy of the biographical page of passport.

3. Two 2-inch photographs.

( II ) Please follow “the enrollment regulations for freshmen” for registration. A proof of medical and personal insurance covering the period of at least six months from the date of arrival in Taiwan must be submitted upon enrollment. The said certification of overseas insurance must be authenticated by an ROC embassy or mission abroad.

( III ) Retaining eligibility for admission

An admitted student who is unable to enroll at the beginning of the semester due to illness, pregnancy, or other incidents or accidents, may apply to the University for retaining his/her eligibility for admission. The admission may be extended for up to one year only. Freshmen with retained admission must apply to the Office of Academic Affairs with the admission letter and written application before the specified semester starting date.

- 1 、 Those who are eligible for “The Elite Scholarship Program: MOE Scholarship for Lecturers from South and Southeast Asian Countries” will receive a maximum of NT\$25,000 per month for a maximal period of 3 years for doctoral programs.
- 2 、 NTUS offers scholarships for international students. Students with outstanding grades may apply for a scholarship and receive a maximum of NT\$60,000 per semester.
